Our watches are entirely manufactured in the heart of the Vallée de Joux. It is in this historically inspirational environment that a small team of specialized craftsmen watchmakers manufacture, finish and assemble components for our timepieces to the highest standards of *Haute Horlogerie*.

The choice of the finest materials is also fundamental to this approach. Everywhere possible, the use of noble metals and innovative materials are combined with matchless finishing in order to ensure the rarity, authenticity and quality of our movements and all their individual components.

We have expressly engraved the 'Vallée de Joux' label on our dials to recall that it is in this privileged valley that all MONTANDON&Co watches are created. It also expresses our philosophy and commitment to design exclusive and reliable watches with a view to long-term values and traditions.

Our movements

In order to maintain and guarantee this high criterion of rarity and quality that we set ourselves, we design, develop and manufacture our own movements. Based on our automatic flying tourbillon caliber with unusual annular rotor construction, our movements integrate new solutions and features. These were specifically invented and developed in the spirit of creating an ultimate 21st century sea-faring chronometer worthy of the exceptional marine chronometers from sailing's golden history.

Inspired by a map's compass rose, the movement's style and finishing characterize a complete and original identity uniquely identifiable as MONTANDON&Co, setting a new aesthetic canon, never seen before.

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Our cases

The case architecture designed by MONTANDON&Co, comprises up to more than 150 individual components depending on the model, with a high level of visual and mechanical sophistication in every detail. Our design has been developed with sportive, nautical aesthetics in mind, as well as with an eye to simultaneously protecting the precious movement under all types of extreme conditions. A thorough study was made to ensure that the perfect balance between ergonomics and functionality was achieved.



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Our dials and hands

The dial and hands form the essential and intimate interface between the watch and its user. So it is natural that we execute these characteristic parts with the same dedication to detail and perfection as we give to the design of our movements and cases. Easily overlooked, they hold a specific and important role within the most prestigious areas of the watchmaker's art. They visually repeat and embody the aesthetic codes of the brand, and therefore we only manufacture them using noble metals.
